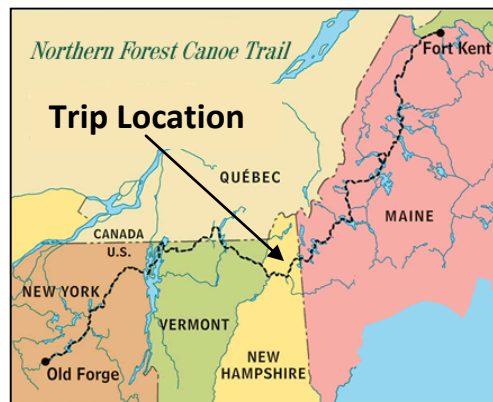

If cancellation occurs more than 2 days prior to reservation, there is no charge. Cancellations less than 2 days prior to reservation (includes no shows) will result in a \$100 fee.

Venture northwards to the quaint town of **Milan, NH**, situated on the fertile banks of the Androscoggin River. This historic farming village (c.1771) is surrounded with exquisite views of the Presidential and Mahoosuc mountain ranges and offers a great array of outdoor recreation activities.



Wake up in your comfortable and well-kept room at the [DuBee Our Guest Bed and Breakfast](#). This cozy B&B offers a common room, a full kitchen and a choice of rooms with private or shared baths. After being treated to a delicious breakfast, your journey will begin when you pick up your rented canoe or kayaks from [North Woods Rafting](#). Shuttle services are also available. From here, drive north along Rte. 16 and stop in at the [Milan Luncheonette](#) or [Ursula's Snack Shack](#) with a \$25 voucher for lunch. From there, you will continue north past osprey and eagle nests to Pontook Reservoir. These serene waters are home to a great diversity of wildlife including loon, eagle and moose. Further north, you can access Lake Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge. Your [NFCT Map 7](#) includes information on put-ins and the region's natural and cultural history.

At the end of the day, you will return to the [DuBee Our Guest Bed and Breakfast](#). You will be given a choice of three local restaurants for dinner and receive a \$35 voucher to the restaurant of your choice.

In the morning, after breakfast you can make your way to Hampshire Highlands, an alpaca farm selling beautifully crafted and locally made alpaca yarn and clothing. Locally made stained glass, wood carvings and maple syrup are also sold here. You can also make an appointment at The Stone Rappers (603-449- 7396) to peruse their lovely wire wrapped jewelry crafted from local gems and minerals.

Before departing, drive up to the Milan Hill State Park where you can climb up a fire tower and enjoy spectacular, 360 degree views of the Presidential and Mahoosuc Mountains.
