Ever want to paddle “north of the border?” Here’s your chance!

The [Northern Forest Canoe Trail](#) is partnering with the [Magestik Bed and Breakfast](#) and through-paddler recommended outfitter [Canoe and Co.](#) to offer visitors a unique experience in the Eastern Townships. Camp out or sleep in style, and take time to explore the Missisquoi River’s headwaters, quaint Quebecois villages, scenic trails, and quiet back roads. Package Includes:

- **Lodging at the Magestik Bed and Breakfast:** Nested in the hills above the Missisquoi, this bed and breakfast has three comfortable rooms and a cozy downstairs to relax in. Alternatively, a covered shelter nestled against a rocky cliff provides visitors with a more rustic lodging experience. Visitors can **opt for a dinner in**, complete with a bottle of homemade wine. If the water levels are adequate, experienced paddlers can **consider paddling across the border** to Richford Vermont, and spend a night at the historic [Grey Gables Inn](#).
- **Upper Missisquoi River Outings:** We recommend spending 1-2 days exploring the NFCT in this region. Stretches with gentle currents and jungle-like floodplain forest makes an upper Missisquoi river trip a great family excursion. Shuttling services and boat rentals can be arranged through a partnership with the local outfitter, [Canoe and Co.](#)



Off the water, visitors have other options to consider. Hikers will appreciate the chance to explore the 200 km [Sentiers de l’Estrie](#), or Trail of the Eastern Townships, a route traversing the surrounding ridgelines. Cyclists



can follow the [Route Verte](#) – an extensive network of marked bicycle routes. Get a sense of Quebecois culture at the village of Mansonville, where a meal at the [Owl’s Head Bakery](#) is not to be missed. Those seeking to experience the diverse culture of the region can participate in the regions [Arts Tour and Circuit](#), which offers tourists an opportunity to visit local artists’ workshops.
