


Northern Forest Canoe Trail **Hike, Bike and Paddle**Vacation Package

Explore some of northern

New Hampshire's most breathtaking wilderness!



Day 1

On your first day, your seasoned guide from <u>Outdoor ESCAPES</u>
<u>New Hampshire</u> will meet you at your lodging (see choices below) and take you on an unforgettable kayak or canoe paddle through the **Lake Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge**. The Refuge's lake and wetlands were ranked by the Boston Globe among the **10** best paddling destinations in New England.

"Rest the paddle on the deck and watch the wildlife at work and play in Lake Umbagog National Wildlife Refuge: winter wrens and purple finches, great blue herons and black ducks, northern leopard frogs and salamanders, loons and eagles." (Boston.com) Your guide will provide paddling instruction, safety oversight, shuttle services and a delicious trail lunch.

Day 2

On your second day, the prime moose habitat, waterfalls and gurgling brooks of the Dartmouth Grant await. The Grant itself is managed by Dartmouth College for sustainable forestry, recreation and natural habitat preservation. Explore the dirt roads by bike on your own or with your guide from Outdoor ESCAPES. Guided trips include a trail lunch. Bike rentals, sales and gear are available from Porky Gulch Bike Shop in Gorham.



Day 3

On the third day of your adventure you will head to Dixville Notch to visit waterfalls and take a self-guided, moderate hike to <u>Table Rock</u>, a narrow granite fin measuring 10 feet across in places and dropping 700 feet on either side. This dramatic outlook offers views of the surrounding cliffs and the Balsams Grand Resort Hotel.
