Come and paddle the northern Connecticut River, home to nesting osprey, Canada geese and a thriving population of wild brook trout. Enjoy views of bucolic farmlands and rolling hills on the River's slow moving current.

## Day 1

After a restful night in a pine paneled room at the well-kept and friendly [Northern Comfort Motel](#), you will be met by your seasoned guide from [Outdoor ESCAPES New Hampshire](#). In addition to overseeing all of your trip logistics and shuttle services, your guide will help you feel at ease in your canoe or kayak while you paddle downstream. She will also share insights into the River's wildlife and human history and provide a shoreline picnic.

At the end of the day, you will arrive at the [Blueberry Hill Inn - Café and Campground](#), an early Colonial farmhouse surrounded by 50-acres of blueberry fields and woods. A hot shower, steak dinner and soft bed will be the perfect end to your day on the water!

## Day 2

In the morning, you will be treated to a sumptuous breakfast menu with the Inn's specialty omelets and muffins made with berries picked on the property. From there, your guide will bring you back to the River for another day of wildlife viewing, paddling and play.

In the afternoon, you will arrive at the [Trailside Lodge](#) where you can spread out in one of the spacious and fully furnished apartments overlooking mountain views. You can make your own dinner in your kitchenette there or your host will suggest a local restaurant.
