Day One - Arrival

Arrive & settle into your vacation rental, a 2-3 bedroom apartment or cottage in North Troy. All rentals have complimentary wifi internet access, and provide easy access to your week's activities.

Day 2 - Kayaking, site-seeing, and shopping

Get an early start and drive to [Clyde River Recreation](#) in West Charleston, where you'll embark on a 3-hour self-guided kayak paddle on the Clyde River in West Charleston. On this 5.5 mile paddle, gentle currents, an abundance of wildlife, and mountain views will keep you curious about what awaits around the next bend.

In the afternoon, drive to the town of **Derby Line**, stopping on the way to view **reindeer and elk feeding** in their pasture, and then on to the famous [Haskell Opera House and Library](#). This beautiful, historic building sits astride an international boundary line. On your drive back to North Troy, stop in at [Couture's Maple Store](#) to sample the wide assortment of maple products produced at this award-winning Sugar House.



Day 3 - Swimming, Fishing and Relaxing

Make a picnic lunch and head out to the beautiful [Four Corners Swimming Hole](#) located 3 miles from your accommodation. If you have your own fishing gear you can try your hand at catching rainbow and brook trout at this hidden spot - with any luck you'll be having fish for dinner.



Day 4 - Canoeing, swimming, fishing and biking



Head back to Newport for a **day at the beach on Lake Memphremagog at Gardner Park**. You'll get a canoe from Clyde River Recreation, and be able paddle for three hours around the South Bay. The marshy inlets to both the Black and Barton Rivers keep begging for further exploration - keep your eye out for wood duck, moose, and muskrat. This package includes a voucher for lunch at the [Montgomery Café](#) in downtown Newport. After lunch, pick up a comfortable bike from [The Great Outdoors of Newport](#) and cycle around the lake to the Canadian border. You'll have the bike until 5 pm.

Day 5 - Tram ride, hiking, swimming

You'll visit [Jay Peak Resort](#) where you can take a **tram ride the top of the mountain and view four states**, plus Canada. Explore this mountain ridge and either take the tram down to the base lodge or hike your way back to the parking lot. After this hike, it is back to the Four Corners Swimming Hole for a lazy afternoon relaxing by the river. When you leave, you can drive the scenic road through Troy and visit scenic [Big Falls](#).



Day 6 - Cheese factory tour and scenic country drive

Take an educational trip to [Cabot Creamery](#), where you and your family will learn how the world's best cheese is made. Drive through the Green Mountains and discover the delightful villages and hamlets of northern and central Vermont.

Day 7 - Check out and head home

Enjoy one last morning in the north country before checking out of your rental by 11 A.M, taking home memories to last a lifetime!
