- NFCT Campsite Sign

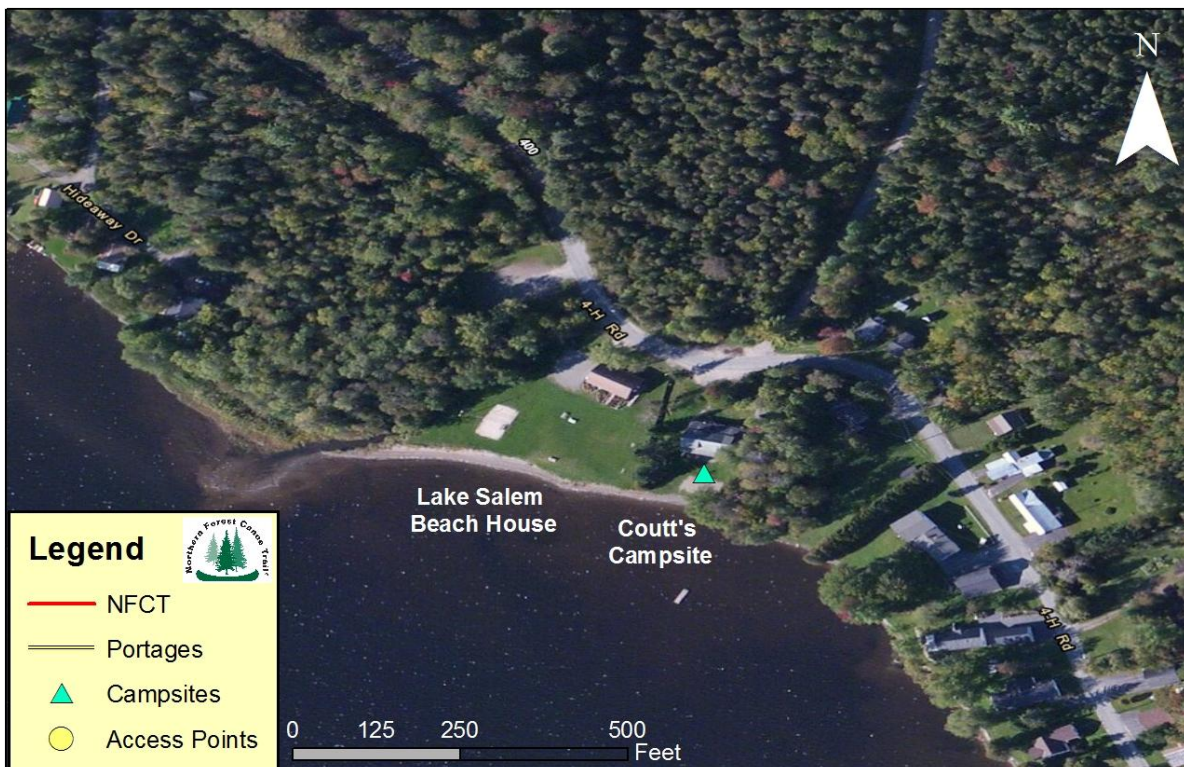
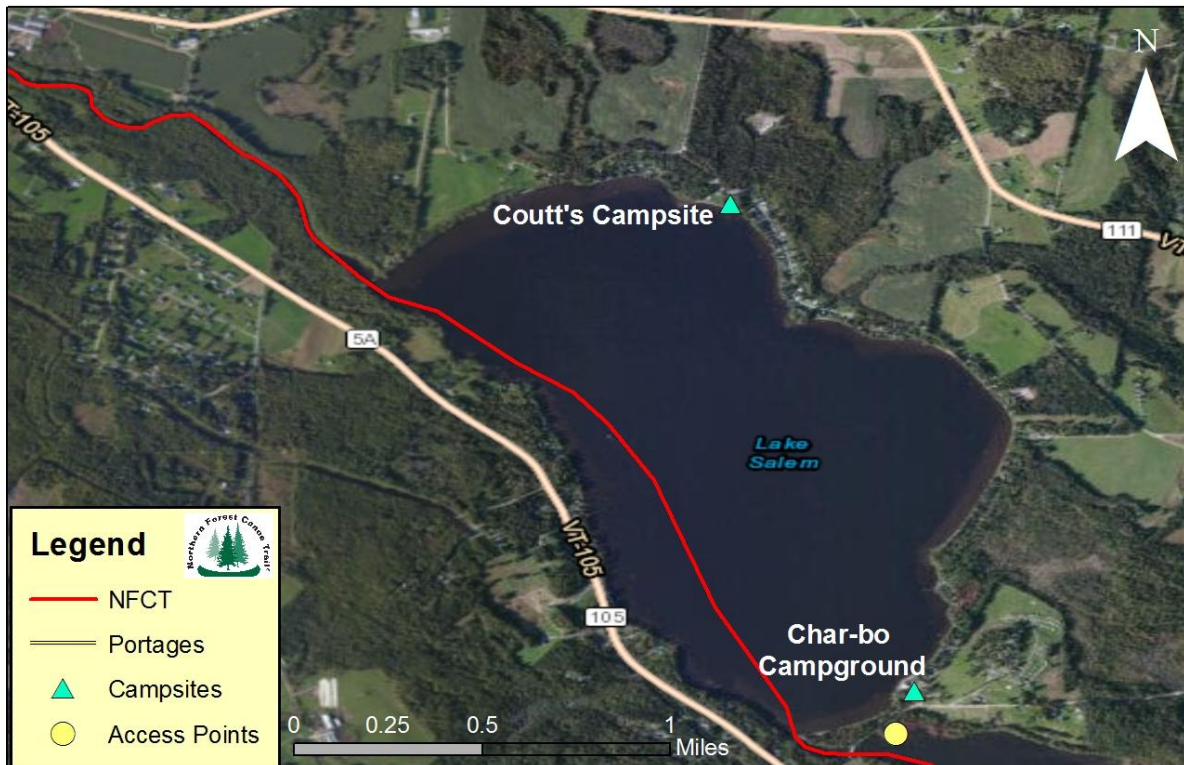
There are public restrooms available at the Lake Salem Beach House (adjoining property to the west). Lake Salem Beach House is a Town of Derby park. The campsite is nestled next to a swimming beach and volleyball court used by the Coots-Moriarty Camp.

Site Information: Use of this campsite is based on an agreement the NFCT maintains with a private landowner. Site is first come first serve and limited to three tents. Please respect this location and carry out what you carry in. Store all personal gear and boats in a manner that does not disturb camp operations.
