Location: Believe it or Not Campsite

Waterbody: Missisquoi River

Town: Richford, VT

Lat/Long: 44° 59' 28.47" N, 72° 40' 53.96" W

Elevation: 427 feet

Overview: In 2013 the NFCT installed a stone staircase access at Davis Park in Richford, VT as well as a new primitive campsite located just downstream from Davis Park. The town still allows camping in Davis Park as needed, but we recommend that paddlers stay at the new "Believe it or Not" Campsite as it is more secluded.

Site Information: The campsite is located at the downstream end of a small canal that was built to help with flooding associated with ice jams. The NFCT maintains a floating log ladder to help you access a trail that will lead to the campsite. The campsite, which is located approximately 50 yards away from the river, can accommodate three tents and has a picnic table and small box privy.

The NFCT works to maintain landowner agreements and maintain the access, portage, and campsites along the 740-mile trail corridor. Please [become a member](#) or give to the [Trail Fund](#) to keep the Trail alive.
