


## NFCT Trail Update

Map: 4 Date of Update: 3-2-15 Location: North Hero State Park Waterbody: Lake Champlain Town: Hero Island, VT Lat/Long: 44° 55' 14.40"N, 73° 14' 25.79" W Elevation: 98 ft

**Overview:** In 2012 North Hero State Park became a day-use only park, with the exception of two paddler access campsites.

**Site Information:** There is no fee for the paddler campsites. There is a porta-potty available at the day-use area (approximately .3 miles from the paddler campsites) and a telephone available at the ranger station (approximately .75 miles from the paddler campsites). You can see a map of North Hero State Park by following this <u>link</u>. Practice all <u>Leave No Trace Principals</u>. Each campsite has room for up to three tents, a picnic table, and a fire ring.
