



# NFCT Trail Update

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**Map:** 4

**Date of Update:** 3-2-15

**Location:** North Hero State Park

**Waterbody:** Lake Champlain

**Town:** Hero Island, VT

**Lat/Long:** 44° 55' 14.40"N, 73° 14' 25.79" W

**Elevation:** 98 ft

**Overview:** In 2012 North Hero State Park became a day-use only park, with the exception of two paddler access campsites.

**Site Information:** There is no fee for the paddler campsites. There is a porta-potty available at the day-use area (approximately .3 miles from the paddler campsites) and a telephone available at the ranger station (approximately .75 miles from the paddler campsites).
