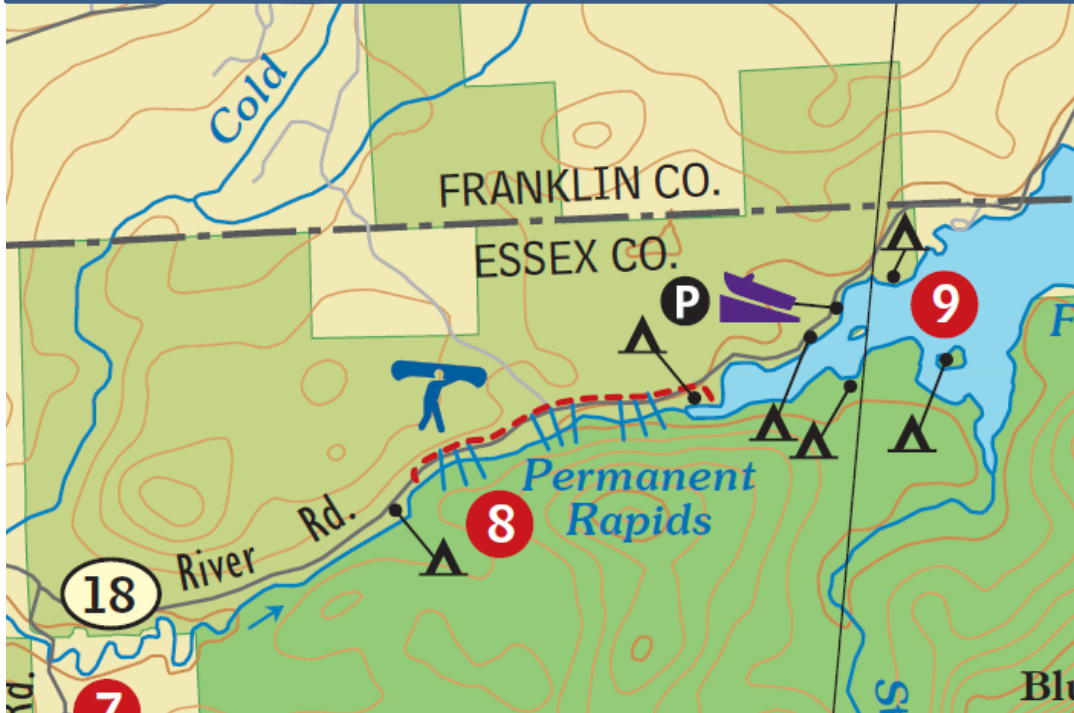
**Elevation:** 1520 ft.

**Overview:** In 2013 the NFCT installed a high-water take-out option at Permanent Rapids. During high-water flows the low-water take-out can prove challenging due to its proximity to the rapids. Follow this [link](#) to see a video of the work.

**Site Information:** Both the high and low water take-outs are located on river left approximately 1.75 miles downstream of the Moose Pond Road crossing. The high-water take-out is approximately 3,000 feet upstream of the low-water take-out. Approach Permanent Rapids with caution, especially during high waters.
