



# NFCT Trail Update

**Map:** 10

**Date of Update:** 3-15-2015

**Location:** Spencer Dam

**Waterbody:** Spencer Lake

**Town:** West Forks, ME

**Lat/Long:** 45° 21' 54.75" N, 70° 16' 24.73" W

**Elevation:** 1,080 feet

**Overview:** Map 10 makes note of a being able to drag your paddle craft up a “washed-out” dam at the southern end of Spencer Lake. Since publication of the map the dam has been rebuilt. It is recommended that paddlers use a corridor located on river left to portage around the dam.

**Site Information:** There are several small coves on river left, just downstream of the dam. With proper scouting you will find an adequate corridor to portage around the dam. Please respect the landowner and ensure you follow all Leave No Trace Principals. It is the wish of the landowner that we do not mark the corridor with blazes or signage.
