



# NFCT Trail Update

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**Map:** 10

**Date of Update:** 9-15-2006

**Location:** Spencer Rips Road Portage

**Waterbody:** Spencer Lake-Moose River

**Town:** Jackman, ME

**Lat/Long:** 45° 27' 33.20"N, 70° 17' 59.76" W

**Elevation:** 1,101 feet

**Overview:** The Chub Pond-Hall Pond-Whipple Pond navigation option is not recommended. Based on paddler feedback, the waterways connecting the ponds are very grown in and typically too shallow for navigation. It is instead recommended to portage down Spencer Road (marked as Hardscrabble Road on NFCT Map 10) and Spencer Rips Road.

**Site Information:** Follow the inlet of Fish Pond to a take-out at Spencer Road Bridge. Follow Spencer Road to the east for 2.3 miles. Take a turn to the north (left) on Spencer Rips Road. Follow Spencer Rips Road for 3 miles to the Moose River Access at the Spencer Rips Campsite. Please remember to sign-in at the NFCT Sign-in Box.
